After serious deliberations, all the proposals mentioned above were approved by the board. The board approved the syllabus of the existing theory courses and allowed the modifications/changes to the tune of more than 20 percent. It was also resolved to introduce some new courses in the syllabus. The board further advised the Departmen to start preparing for integrated (Integrated MSW Programme as per NEP 2020) in case there is availability of human resource and infrastructure for the said course furthermore, guidelines for field work were also approved after necessary inputs from the members. Lastly, the syllabus for the subject of Social work for Post-graduate programme (PG) was approved to be effective from the next academic session i.e., 2024-25.
