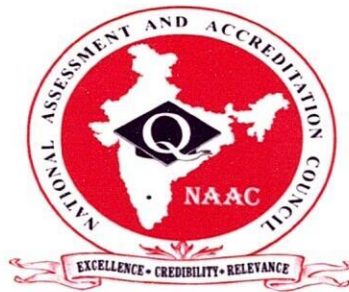

- Guide in preparation of SSR and make them understand intent of metrics and SOP.
- Use innovative methods to achieve the objective.
- Motivate and inspire mentee HEIs to proceed with A and A process, by explaining its benefits.

- Report the monthly progress to the head of mentor-mentee cell of HEI's under the scheme.
- Help in preparing final report to be submitted to NAAC by mentor HEI.

Submission of report

After successful completion of the scheme mentor HEI must submit detailed report to NAAC to review the performance of the mentee HEI endorsed by head of the mentor institution and NAAC officer.

Terms and conditions

- The applicant mentee HEI (GDC, Bomai) is applying first time for accreditation of NAAC.
- Mentor (University of Kashmir) will have no financial obligations, whatsoever, towards the Mentee Institute.
- If any violation found on the part of mentee institution, it shall be liable for appropriate actions from Mentor institute/NAAC.
- Mentee Institute, after proper mentorship, as and when due is bound to: -
 - Register itself on NAAC portal
 - Submit IIQA
 - Prepare & submit SSR
