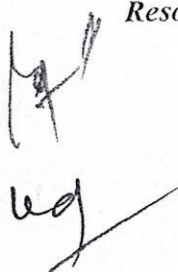

At the very outset the Dean, Academic Affairs after having extended a warm welcome to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, welcomed all the members present as well as the special invitees. The Vice-Chancellor in his remarks appreciated the Dean's and Head of the Departments for their efforts to shift the examinations to offline mode. The Vice-Chancellor advised the HOD's to ensure strict adherence to academic calendar, punctuality of staff and timely completion of syllabi. The house Committee was informed that:-

- a. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was under consideration between School of Law of Central University of Kashmir and the corresponding school of University of Kashmir for sharing of credits and other collaborations in research. A similar type of MoU was proposed between School of Biological Sciences and SKAUST, Kashmir.
 - b. In response to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor's opening remarks, it was desired that a working paper needs to be prepared by the Dean Academic Affairs for its presentation to the Govt., so as to highlight the modalities for implementation of National Education Policy -2020 and develop a desired connect between colleges and University for running integrated [UG/PG] programmes.

Candidates carrying backlog will be eligible to appear in the backlog courses at the subsequent examination for the concerned semester with changes in the course content, if any. There will be supplementary examination for the 5 th & 6 th semesters only and such an examination shall be held as per the academic calendar.	There will be no supplementary examination for 1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd & 4 th Semester and the candidate/s carrying backlog paper/s in these semesters shall be eligible to appear in the backlog paper/s at the subsequent examination of the concerned semesters as per revised syllabus. However, the condition of appearing in the backlog examination as per revised syllabus shall not be applicable in case of major changes in course content or change in course titles and in such circumstances question paper for backlog candidates shall be available as per the previous syllabus of the batch of students to which such candidate/s belongs to. Provided that supplementary examination shall be conducted for 5 th & 6 th Semester immediately after the main examination as per the academic calendar with the existing syllabus.

Resolved that the amendment to Regulation XII (2) of the Statutes governing Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), at UG level be endorsed.

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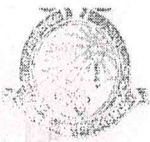
