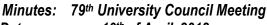

Introductory Remarks

Chancellor welcomed the members of the University Council (UC) and invited the Vice-Chancellor (VC) to present details achieved since the last meeting of the

Council.

a) VC made a Power Point Presentation on the recent initiatives/achievements of the University.

b) Chancellor and Council Members noted with satisfaction that the University had secured the

47th position among the top 100 Universities in the country under the National Institutional

Ranking Framework. Council advised VC to make concrete efforts to further improved the

section wise and overall ranking by focussing on improving student diversity, Perception

Index and different aspects of Intellectual Property Rights

c) Chancellor and Council members made the following observations/comments before the

agenda items were taken up for discussion:

Chancellor advised the Vice-Chancellor:

i. To fully utilise ICT based teaching tools besides utilising programmes like GIAN,

MOOCs, etc. which have the potential to connect the students and Faculty to the best

online educational resources.

ii. To effectively use the existing online student feedback system for evaluating the

performances of individual teachers in order to make qualitative improvement in the

assessment system of the faculty.

iii. To optimally utilize the University resources.

iv. VCs of Kashmir and Jammu Universities were advised to urgently evolve a suitable

Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship Scheme to encourage meritorious students.

v. To qualitatively improve the overall functioning of the University, on continuing basis.

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vi. To review all Academic Programmes and have undertaken Performance Audit and External Review of ongoing Research Programmes/Centres to assess their contemporary relevance.

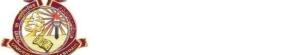

Introductory Remarks

Hon'ble Chancellor welcomed the members of the University Council (UC) and invited the Vice-Chancellor (VC) to present the details of progress made by the University since the last meeting of the Council.

- a) Vice-Chancellor (VC) made a Power Point Presentation on the recent initiatives/achievements of the University.

- c) The Chancellor made the following observations/comments before the agenda items were taken up for discussion:

Chancellor advised the Vice-Chancellor:

- i. to adopt a futuristic approach for upgradation of infrastructure facilities and various academic and research programmes on various subjects with special focus on most recent advancements.
- ii. to stress on promoting excellence in teaching, research and extension activities and also strengthening of technical education.
- to upgrade e-learning and other teaching tools to provide the students with the enhanced iii. educational resource platforms.
- to focus on capacity building, innovative, job oriented and skill development courses for the iv. students to meet the industry and other modern day requirements and global trends.
- While appreciating the collaboration of University with Montana Tech, The University of V. Montana, USA, particularly for conservation of Biodiversity, Chancellor impressed upon University that the expertise should be also utilized for conservation of Dal Lake and other endangered/shrinking resources. He further advised that College students from UT of J&K should also be roped in for awareness/conservation of natural resources.

Introductory Remarks

Hon'ble Chancellor welcomed the members of the University Council (UC) and invited Prof. Talat Ahmad, Vice-Chancellor to present the details of progress made by the University since the last meeting of the Council.

After the presentation made by the Vice Chancellor, the Hon'ble Chancellor appreciated the University for excellent performance in all spheres including the national and international rankings.

Notably:

- a) The University of Kashmir has been accredited as **Grade-A+** by the National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC) of India.
- b) The University of Kashmir has been ranked at **48**th and **56**th position by NIRF and QS BRICS, respectively
- c) The University of Kashmir has secured ranking in the band 450 500 in the recently conducted QS Rankings amongst Asian Universities.
- d) The University of Kashmir has been ranked at 19th position among 70 best Public State Universities in India by the Outlook magazine for the year 2020.
- e) Establishment of Centres of Excellence and award of SERB, PURSE (DST), FIST (DST) grants etc.

After this the Hon'ble Chancellor made the following observations/comments before the agenda items were taken up for discussion:

Chancellor advised the Vice-Chancellor:

- i. to take comprehensive measures for strengthening the academic and research environment in the University.
- ii. to identify the challenges in the implementation of NEP 2020 and prepare a plan accordingly, thus making the Higher Education sector effective, result-oriented and more vibrant.
- iii. to prepare a roadmap to bring in qualitative improvement in the overall functioning of the University, strengthening the research ecosystem, besides up gradation of infrastructural facilities and various academic and research programmes on varied subjects, with special focus on most recent advancements.
- iv. to adopt best method of teaching along with the regular capacity building of teaching faculty of the University Campuses, incorporating students' feedback and making qualitative improvement in the assessment of the students' feedback system for evaluating the performance of individual teachers.
- v. to impart tourism and hospitality based training and research in the University.

vi. to utilize all available ICT technology based teaching programmes and updating of e-learning and other teaching tools to connect the students and faculty with the enhanced educational resource platforms.

- vii. to promote excellence in teaching, research and extension activities, strengthening technical education, optimum utilization of University's resources by evolving best practices for maintaining transparency in all student-related matters.
- viii. to focus on job oriented and skill development courses for the students to meet the modern day requirements.
- ix. to focus on seeking more funding from ICSSR and similar agencies and to enhance focus on Humanities and Social Science subjects and also **bring** reforms to the social science faculty for better governance.
- x. to promote Inter-State and Intra-UT collaborations. University of Kashmir should also do hand-holding of new Universities in the Union Territory.
- xi. to focus on promoting more number of start-ups in the Incubations Centres and to incentivise the same by integrating with CBCS Choice Based Credit System.
- xii. to develop stronger linkages with local industry for providing employable work force to the new projects from within the Union Territory.
- xiii. to lay serious emphasis on the Mental Health Education and other societal issues and prepare a workable plan through the involvement of experts in Social Work Department and allied subjects.
- xiv. to prepare a system for analysing the student's feedback regarding the functioning of the University.

With regard to enhancement of age of superannuation of teachers in the University, after detailed deliberation it was resolved that in view of strong justification the age of superannuating of only Professors having vast experience of research and academics can be considered for enhancement from 62 years to 65 years in terms of UGC guidelines.

Introductory Remarks

At the outset, Hon'ble Chancellor welcomed all the members of the University Council (UC) and invited Prof. Nilofer Khan, Vice-Chancellor to present the details of progress made by the University since the last meeting of the Council.

Vice Chancellor while making the presentation highlighted major achievements of the University including the following.

- a) University of Kashmir figures in top 100 Universities in the Country.
- b) University of Kashmir is among first Universities to successfully implement NEP-2020.
- c) University got 50 crore grant under component 10 of RUSA 2.0.
- d) 14 research proposals were recommended by the external expert committee.
- e) Launch of various e-governance initiatives on administrative reforms developed inhouse by the Directorate of IT & SS.
- f) To strengthen the research ecosystem, University actively supports the National Brain Gain Mission.
- g) Nine (09) Kashmir University scientists make it to Stanford University's research database.
- h) Massive push to foster the Culture of Entrepreneurship and Innovations.
- i) Through Directorate of Lifelong Learning and Deendayal Upadhyaya KAUSHAL Kendra and CCPC encouraging number of pass outs were placed in various agencies.
- i) Kashmir University chosen among 15 institutions for Y-20 events.
- k) Dean Students Welfare and Centre for Women's Studies conducted various seminars/awareness programs on Gender equity and women's empowerment.
- 1) University of Kashmir selected as one of the Pilot institutions for participation in GATI Pilot project.
- m) University of Kashmir Signed MoU with Chinar Corps for provision of distance education courses to soldiers serving in Kashmir.

Appreciating the above noted achievements, the Hon'ble Chancellor stressed the need for sustained efforts to strive forward towards excellence in different arena nationally and internationally.

After this the Hon'ble Chancellor made the following observations/comments before the agenda items were taken up for discussion with a view to:





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i. impress on time-bound completion and award of Ph.D degrees to the students. He desired an assessment of the average number of years spent by students from the date of their registration till award to be submitted to his Secretariat, while stressing the need to avoid unnecessary delay at any level

- ii. stressing the need to conduct research activities focused on local environmental and socially relevant issues by the University. Such applied research and scientific intervention should be aimed at providing solutions to local problems being faced by the society. This would help in creating a knowledge base which can be shared to improve decision making and to serve as building blocks in the creation of new knowledge in future.
- iii. stressing the need for special focus on skill development and capacity building programmes.
- iv. stressing the need to build a strong eco-system for nurturing innovation and start-ups and the Government shall provide all the required assistance.
- v. stressing the need to adhere to Academic and Examinations calendars.
- vi. stressing the need to make an assessment of various seminars, especially relating to applied knowledge for industrial purposes.
- vii. stressing the need to make e-office fully functional in the University. He advised the Vice Chancellor to submit to his Secretariat a road map for completely switching over to e-office and to work in a planned and time bound manner towards the same.
