








Examination Overview

Brief description of the examination system:

The examination and results are the final outcome of teaching - learning process in the university. All efforts are made to establish the examination system and strengthen the same in a manner that it is more efficient and student friendly. The bench mark of credibility; transparency and efficiency have been maintained in all examination processes without fail. The examination has been institutionalized at all levels in most organized and systematic manner

Physical Infrastructure:

The University has housed whole examination system in an independent spacious building sprawling over huge land mass equipped with all the required modern facilities. All the officers have separate offices with internet, intercom, telephone and computer facilities. Each office has separate long size rectangular rooms with officials sitting in a hierarchical order making it a perfect arrangement of office management.

The examination building is annexed with large size evaluation halls for evaluation of answer scripts of different semesters as and when required. The building is also housing a full-fledged multipurpose automation cell which is well equipped with systems loaded with desired software with Internet facility manned by system engineers, programmers and data Entry operators sufficient to facilitate online end to end processes.

The facilities for typing and printing of question papers of all the courses have been put in place in the safely guarded Secrecy Section of the Examination building.

Examination Management:

The Examination management is headed by a full time Controller of Examinations who has experience in Academic Administration and Examination. He is assisted by a large number of able officers and officials, who work with scientific division of labor without any overlap of the profile in order to avoid waste of labor and to enforce efficiency for which the following specialized sections have been created.

1. Automation Section

Automation Section housed in the examination building performs multifaceted tasks and functions as a support service for examination related activities. The use of information & Communication Technology (ICT) in the examination processes has ushered in flexibility and efficiency in it. The Automation Wing comprising of team of engineers with large base of hardware infrastructure and indigenous software platform which control and administer the web based network system linking colleges and students with the university;

This e-Governed system offers students an online facility to apply for exams and pay fee online. They can download the examination forms for their respective UG/PG courses (Professional/Non-professional). After submitting the examination form, students can download their admit cards, can check their eligibility, fee status and results of their respective courses

This e-governed system enables students and colleges to view/print their respective results by simply entering their name or roll number or registration number in the search box. Examination section has been provided with a user friendly interface to upload results from their respective sections. Printing of Academic Transcripts and Degree certificates immediate after the declaration of result

2. Conduct Section:

The University has a mandate to conduct examination of UG non- Professional (private/regular), UG Professional, PG Non Professional (private/regular), PG Professional, Diploma, Certificate and Pre-PhD courses. The conduct section at the University of Kashmir in manages and coordinating various administrative tasks, including the timely issuance of date sheets, notifications, and the delivery of academic transcripts for colleges and departments. This section ensures that all relevant information, such as examination schedules and center notices, is efficiently communicated to students and faculty. By maintaining a streamlined process for these essential functions, the conduct section supports the smooth operation of academic activities and helps maintain the university's standards of excellence.

3. Secrecy Section:

The Secrecy Section at the University of Kashmir is responsible for maintaining the confidentiality and integrity of the examination process. This includes the secure handling of examination papers, the proper coding of answer scripts. In order to maintain sanctity of the Examination, Secrecy Sections have to be manned by the persons of integrity and probity. All the processes involved in Secrecy of Question Papers have to be efficiently managed for which chosen personnel have been posted in two Secrecy Sections. These sections are headed by the Assistant and Deputy Controller of Examinations.

4. Evaluation Section:

Evaluation Sections have been divided into two Sections of UG and PG/Professional with a mandate to receive Answer scripts from various examination centers and to arrange their evaluation. The evaluation section is headed by the Assistant Controller who coordinates evaluation at different centers and maintains its record. A separate



Section is maintained for re- evaluation of the Answer Scripts if the candidate is not satisfied with the first evaluation. This Section consolidates all the online applications submitted for re-evaluation and ensures re-evaluation of the Answer Scripts in a time bound manner.

5. Tabulation Section:

The evaluation section forwards result data to the tabulation section which is headed by the Assistant Controller (Tabulation). This section consolidates result awards of all the courses and verifies them before submitting for processing of result.

6. Certificate Section:

The Certificate Section is supervised by the Assistant Controller of Examinations who has a team of officials assisting in preparation and dispatch of degree certificates to respective colleges or Departments as the case may be.

7. Accounts Section:

The University as a matter of policy to attract efficient and careful paper setters and evaluators provides a token of honorarium to all those associated with examination processes. To ensure timely payment and to observe financial rules strictly, an Accounts Section has been established for maintaining examination accounts, headed by the Assistant Controller (Accounts) who is assisted by a team of officials who are proficient in examination accounting.

8. Transport Section:

The examination Section is supported by a good number of vehicles of different description that are used to ferry Answer Books to different examination and evaluation centers. The University also keeps vehicles ready from common pool as and when asked for to ensure timely delivery of Question Papers to all the Examination Centers spread over far and wide.

Examination Processes:

The examinations process for all the PG course offered by the University are being conducted by the respective PG departments, including the evaluation process and submission of marks awards (Internal/External) online.

The Examination of professional courses which include (MD/MS, MBBS,BDS,BUMS and B.E/B.Tech are conducted as per already fixed academic/examination calendar and the candidates are able to complete their degrees in a stipulated time period.

At under Graduate level where the enrolment is large and is running in lacks, the examination and evaluation process has been decentralized among the stake holders so that processes are spread over all the affiliated colleges for the purpose of conduct and evaluation. The process of examination starts with the submission of forms that are made available online. Once the preparation of paper setting is complete the link for online submission of forms is opened for fixed period, wherein the students have to fill up and submit the details regarding the subject stream to choose combination of subjects. On the basis of number of candidates' subject wise in each college, the statement of examination centres is prepared and notified on the university Website while ensuring that students are

able to take examination in their own college/Institutions.

The university of Kashmir has adopted National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 from the academic session 2022 with the aim to have holistic and multidisciplinary undergraduate education that ensures access, equity, quality and gives equal importance to affordability and accountability to produce well rounded and skill oriented employable graduates, the thrust of NEP 2020 is on continuous and holistic learning through Multi-disciplinary and Interdisciplinary approach, the student is required to earn Credits by opting for Major, Minor, Multidisciplinary, Ability Enhancement, Value-Added, and Skill Enhancement Courses under various disciplines at the time of admission. This system aims to strengthen the academic potential of the student, as it provides flexibility in the choice of courses offered beyond the framework of the respective disciplines of study, as also increased employability. The Undergraduate Programme (UGP) structure has been designed with options for a Single Major with a Minor discipline or Dual Major disciplines. Students will have the option to exit after One Year with a Certificate, Two Years with a Diploma and Three Years with Bachelor's Degree. Successful completion of Four Years programme will lead to the award of a Bachelor's Degree (Honours/Research) in particular subject/s. Continuation of the undergraduate programmes for the fourth year is optional. The present Post-graduate Programmes in subjects will be restructured into One -Year Master's Degree Programmes for Honours and Two -Year Master's Degree Programmes for the three years Bachelor's Degree holders.

The evaluation of answer scripts is a major challenge which involves both time and manpower. In order to save the time and cost in transit of answer scripts the university has designated various nodal colleges in the valley and established Sub offices in Jammu divisions. On every day of examination the centre superintendents deposit all the answer scripts in the concerned nodal colleges for further process of evaluation. The evaluation process is initiated simultaneously from the second day of examination so that results are declared in a shortest possible time.

As per the evaluation policy the answer scripts are assigned to the teaching faculty in a manner that no examiner evaluates the answer scripts of the students enrolled in his/her college. The awards prepared by the evaluators are submitted online to the university through the IT Cell of the college evaluators created by the university. The same process is being followed by all the nodal colleges and sub offices after cross checking the awards with the answer scripts.


Once the evaluation starts in all the subjects/colleges the marks obtained by the students are made available on the university website so that the students come to know about their evaluation status.

For submission of external/internal practical awards and the theory awards the colleges are required to complete the process before the last date fixed for the purpose so as to declare the result as per the examination calendar.

The result notified is issued and put on University website with a facility to download the details of subject wise marks by the candidates.

Graphical representation of students' academic Data 2019-2023:





GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF ALL COURSES END SEMESTER RESULTS 2019:





GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF ALL COURSES END SEMESTER RESULTS 2020:





GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF ALL COURSES END SEMESTER RESULTS 2021:





GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF ALL COURSES END SEMESTER RESULTS 2022:







GRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF ALL COURSES END SEMESTER RESULTS 2023:




STATISTICAL ANALYSIS OF DISTANCE EDUCATION RESULTS:

Graphical representation of students' academic Data DDE 2019-2023:







Challenges and Improvements

Challenges faced during the examination process:

From 2019 onwards the University of Kashmir faced considerable challenges in its examination processes due to the COVID-19 pandemic, which necessitated a shift to an online learning environment. The pandemic also brought to light the critical issue of student well-being, with increased anxiety and stress stemming from the uncertainty and disruption of traditional learning environments. The abrupt shift to remote learning disrupted the continuity of education, negatively impacting students' preparedness and performance. The university faced numerous operational challenges, including the coordination of exams across different time zones and the need to redesign assessments for online formats, which added to the complexity of the situation. Infrastructure deficits and financial constraints further limited the university's ability to support comprehensive online examinations. Ensuring clear communication and providing timely technical support were essential yet challenging tasks. Additionally, ensuring inclusivity and accessibility for students with disabilities, as well as accommodating diverse linguistic needs, required significant resources and meticulous planning. This period underscored the need for resilient and adaptable examination systems at the University of Kashmir, capable of addressing both technological and human factors amidst unprecedented disruptions.

Feedback from students and faculty:

The examination wing of University of Kashmir's received positive feedback from both students and Faculty during the COVID-19 pandemic for their efforts in conducting exams on time despite the sudden shift to online learning. 


