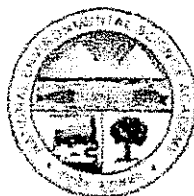

Prof. Azra N. Kamili did her Ph.D in Botany in the year 1984 from University of Kashmir. She is Professor and Director, Centre of Research for Development and also Head Department of Environmental Science, University of Kashmir. She has significantly contributed in fields of Plant Sciences and Environmental Science. She has worked on micropropagation of many medicinal and economically important plants of Kashmir Himalaya. In addition she has worked on antimicrobial and antioxidant activities of number medicinal plants of this region.

Prof. Kamili has also significantly contributed in the field of microbial ecology and produced many research papers related to the microbial flora of various ecosystems. She has 119 research papers and seven books to her credit. She has till date undertaken 14 research projects. Apart from guiding series of M.Sc/M.Tech/ B.Tech projects in Environmental Science and Biotechnology, she has supervised 15 Ph.Ds and 20 M.Phil's in Botany and Environmental Science. Presently 17 Ph.D/ M.Phil scholars are working under her supervision. She has a research experience of about 33 years and teaching experience of about 30 years at P.O. level in Botany, Environmental Science and Plant Biotechnology.

Prof. Kamili is Coordinator of DHT, Govt. of India, sponsored Network Project on Tissue Culture of Saffron (2012-2016). She is the member of various committees at National and state level. She has Received Gold medal, trophy and Certificate of appreciation by FFI at New Delhi for contribution in the field of science in March, 2011 and 'Lady Special Award & Certificate' from IIT Bombay for contribution in the field of Science, April 2012.
