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#### Vision:

#### Mandate:

Professional training is a powerful measure in upholding teacher competence and sustaining teacher motivation. The Orientation Courses are for duration of four weeks. These are essentially concerned with the objective of sensitizing participants on current issues of higher education and immediate social relevance. Due emphasis is laid upon strengthening skills in teaching and communication and bringing innovations in teaching. Attempts are made in motivating and developing competence in scientific research. The young teachers, with less than eight years of experience are eligible for enrolling in these courses.

Refresher Courses are organized for a duration of three weeks. The objective of these courses is to update the teachers with recent developments in their concerned disciplines. Local Programme Planning and Management Committee (LPPMC) decides the subjects for Refresher Courses for the year. The Refresher Courses in various subjects have a definite thrust area.


UGC-Human Resource Development Centre (formerly Academic Staff College) also organizes week long workshops for the principals of degree colleges from the state of Jammu and Kashmir. Every workshop is structured on a definite theme. Apart from these programs, one week training program namely 'Professional Development Programme' is organized for senior teachers and administrators on a focused theme.

## Brief Profile of the University of Kashmir:

The University of Kashmir is situated on the outskirts of Srinagar city at Hazratbal, spread over a sprawling of campus 263 acres of land. flanked by the world famous Dal Lake on one side and Nigeen Lake on the other and situated amidst delightful natural surroundings, with the Himalayan



mountain range in the background. The University was founded as the University of Jammu and Kashmir in 1948 with Mr. A. A. Fayzee as its first whole-time Vice-Chancellor. By an ordinance promulgated by the Governor of the State of J&K on 5 September 1969 - which was subsequently replaced by an Act of the State Legislature, the University of Jammu and Kashmir was bifurcated into two full-fledged Universities: the University of Jammu and the University of Kashmir. The University of Kashmir today is a teaching and affiliating institution recognized under section 2(f) of the UGC Act. In the year 2002, the National Accreditation & Assessment Council (NAAC) of the UGC accredited Kashmir University as an A-Grade University and subsequently re-accredited the University for a further period of five years in August, 2011 at A Grade with a CGPA of 3.11 on a four-point scale. At present the University of Kashmir has 13 faculties, 38 teaching departments and 15 research centers. It offers 65 courses in diverse disciplines of science, arts, humanities and technology. The University has established five satellite campuses in its territorial jurisdiction in South (Anantnag) and North Kashmir (Delina Baramulla) respectively with the aim of reaching out to people living in remote areas of the Kashmir division and providing educational facilities to these communities for their socio-economic development. Three more satellite campuses have been established at Kupwara, Kargil and Leh for the benefit of people living in these far flung areas.

Besides administrative blocks and various departmental buildings, the University Campus comprises of a guest house, hostels, a post office, J&K Bank Branch with ATM counter, shopping complex and Central Allama Iqbal Library. The Allama Iqbal Library along with its network of 43 departmental libraries is the largest library system in the state that round the clock caters to the academic needs of the large chunk of University community consisting of

faculty members, research scholars, PG and diploma students in various disciplines. It is the only ISO 9001:2008 certified library in entire North India. At present, it has a collection of approximately 6.15 lac books, 56,275 journals (Back volumes), 363 manuscripts and rare books, 297 current print journals besides 85000 online journals through portal. The V-SAT and Radio link connectivity installed in the Library provides much needed internet facility to the faculty members, research scholars and PG students.

The University provides reasonably comfortable residential facilities on first-come-first-serve basis to students in five hostels that include three hostels for male students, one for female students and one for research scholars. The University has its own health center with wellqualified doctors, para-medical staff and computerized diagnostic laboratory, X-ray and ECG units. The University has a full-fledged department of Physical Education & Sports with a director and a team of qualified coaches in various sports. University has a Proctoral Organization to ensure security of all the students and prevent incidents like ragging etc. within the campus. A Women's cell in the University headed by the Dean Students Welfare is meant to address issues concerning woman students on the campus. University offers merit and research scholarships as well as Student Aid Fund to the deserving students of the campus. Department of Students' Welfare headed by Dean, Students' Welfare functions for the overall benefit and the welfare of the student community of the University and encourages their participation in various social, cultural and academic activities. There is also a students' grievance cell which redresses any grievances of the students and acts as a bridge between the University authorities and the student community. A Centre for Career Planning and Counseling and an Entrepreneurship Development Cell has also been established in the University.

## About Human Resource Development Centres:

The UGC Academic Staff Colleges (ASC) were established in Universities as autonomous units within them for organizing staff development programmes funded by the UGC. The main objective of Academic Staff Colleges is to provide adequate opportunities for the professional development of teachers in higher education system within the framework of knowledge society to inculcate values, motivation and the skills in the art of teaching. Since, the knowledge explosion worldwide has become phenomenal, it has become difficult to cope with the large volume of knowledge being generated, new information technology and the methodology and techniques of generating and imparting knowledge. The Academic Staff Colleges aim to provide opportunity for the teachers to update the knowledge in the subject, technology and acquire new methods of curricular transactions in each area of their chosen disciplines. The objectives of the Academic Staff College programmes are thus expected to be very different from the traditional B.Ed. /M.Ed. courses.

In the Eleventh Five Year Plan, one more dimension has been added viz., Training in Information Technology and e-content development. With this, the UGC has extended the scope of training to administrative staff in colleges and universities. The ASC draw resources from the parent University as well as academic resources from other institutions within and outside the state according to the needs. They have functional freedom within the broad framework of the UGC guidelines. In continuation of knowledge enhancement, new strategies of governance for



promotion of innovations and creativity, the XII Plan guidelines were proposed to transform the existing 66 academic staff colleges into Human Resource Development Centres.

In order to achieve the objectives laid down under the National Policy on Education (NPE, 1986) and its Programme of Action, an initiative was taken by University Grants Commission in the year 1986 and over a period of time, 66 Academic Staff Colleges (ASCs) were established in different universities. During the last two decades or more, the system of ASCs has come to be accepted well and established in the university system with plan to plan financial support of the UGC and cooperation extended by the universities in providing basic infrastructure and other support, required for functioning of the ASCs. As of now, a total of 66 ASCs are functioning in the institutions of higher education across the country.

In line with the foregoing objectives and for achieving quality assured system for capacitybuilding, continuous knowledge enhancement, new strategies of governance forpromotion of innovations and creativity, new guidelines have been proposed by the UGC totransform the existing ASCs into two level systems in the form of a Scheme of setting upHuman Resource Development Centre (HRDC) and Regional Centres for CapacityBuilding (RCCB) in selected universities in the country to create new such systemscommensurate with the expansion of higher education institutions by the University Grants Commission (UGC) with following broad plan of action.

- a) To organize specially designed Orientation Programmes (OPs) in pedagogy, educational psychology and philosophy, and socio-economic and political concerns forall new entrants at the level of Assistant Professor.
- b) To organize advanced level and more discipline oriented Refresher Courses (RCs), for capacity enhancement and continuous knowledge up-gradation and exposure toemerging developments of faculty involved in teaching in institutions of highereducation.

- c) To ensure that every teacher in higher education system of our country is exposed to an OP and a RC at least once during the first three to five years; of his/her career.
- d) To organize specially designed OPs/RCs to enable the faculty involved in teaching and research in institutions of higher education to utilize fast growing Information and Communication Technology support to teaching and research.

The following main target groups have been identified for capacity building, knowledgeenhancement and similar other programmes with the objective of a holistic approachfocused on transformation of our institutions of higher education to a more facilitatingacademic environment conducive to innovations, creativity and quality advanced learning and research.

- > Faculty members in institutions of higher learning engaged in teaching and research
- Teacher Educators
- Key nonacademic functionaries in institutions of higher learning for better governance and to facilitate efficient use of various fast growing ICT resources and applications
- Research scholars

## About UGC-HRDC, University of Kashmir:

**UGC-Academic** Staff College, University of Kashmir was established in the year 1987 with an aim of generating awareness among the teaching faculty particularly among freshly appointed teachers about linkages



between society, environment, development and education, about philosophy of education, higher education system and pedagogy, resource awareness and knowledge generation and about management and personality development. Overall aim is their professional, personality and career development. To achieve this aim, Academic Staff College of the University of Kashmir endeavours to design, organize, conduct, monitor and evaluate General Orientation and Refresher Courses for college and university teachers; interaction

Programmes for doctoral and post-doctoral scholars; short-term courses for senior administrators, heads of departments, principals, deans and other decision makers and teaching programmes for non-teaching staff, in accordance with UGC guidelines. Besides imparting knowledge and skills to participants of these programmes, Academic Staff College envisages to provide them opportunities to interact with eminent resource persons and facilitate their exchange of ideas with peers from various parts of the state and country as well. This considerably helps in an overall improvement in the quality of education and research in higher education institutes by enhancing the competencies of the teachers.

Since its inception, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir has conducted 74<sup>th</sup> General Orientation and 142 Refresher Courses till March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017 that were attended by a total of 5497 college and university teachers. Besides these courses 19 short-term courses on different topics have also been conducted that were attended by a total of 827 participants that included college principals, heads of departments and senior administrative officers of various educational institutions of the valley. Out of a total of 1917 participants that have attended 74 General Orientation Course conducted by the UGC-Human Resource Development Centre, 1354 were male and 563 were female whereas 1557 participants were from within and 360 from outside the valley of Kashmir. Similarly in case of 143 Refresher Courses conducted by the College so far, out of a total of 3580 participants, 2359 were male and 1221 were female participants whereas 2329 were from within and 1251 from outside the valley of Kashmir. During the session 2016-2017, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir conducted Four General Orientation, Two Refresher and Three short-term courses. Refresher Courses were conducted in the subjects of Home Science, Physics, Chemistry, English, Zoology, Botany, Economics, Computer Application, Biotechnology, History, Commerce, Law, Education, Sociology, etc. Other Course Special Winter School and short term courses were conducted on Research Methodology in Sciences, Social Sciences, and IT Workshop.

With the new education policy being drafted for the country, the challenges for higher educational institutions are getting compounded day in and day out. The institutions have to come up to the expectations of all the stakeholders-students, teachers & society. In such a scenario, the knowledge creation and its transfer requires a well thought out vision, a well documented action plan and a well managed administrative system. India, being a country with the highest young population needs to take advantage of this situation and develop adequate human resources not only for herself but also for the world economy. As a sequel to this, a target of 30% Gross Enrolment Ratio was fixed to be achieved by the end of the 12<sup>th</sup> five year plan and the thrust areas to be covered were identified as expansion, inclusiveness, quality, relevance and value based education. This demands a fresh look towards whole higher education system of the country and orient it to accommodate these five areas. Consequent upon this, the mission and vision of higher education needs to be recreated, the objectives to be re-defined, the strategies to be re-formulated, and the system to be re-designed. With this changed milieu, the human resources manning the organizations engaged in higher education need a fresh mind set, a new set of skills, and an innovative approach to the creation, & transfer of knowledge in the society. Realising this fact, the 66

Human Resource Development Centers established by the UGC are supposed to act as change agents and bring transformation throughout the country. The Human Resource Development Center, University of Kashmir (UGC-HRDC) is one of them.

The Vision of UGC-HRDC envisages to contribute to the nation building by training Academic and Administrative human resources for the higher educational institutions of the country at par with international standards. In the next 5 years, the UGC-HRDC aspires to become a state of the art world class institution craving for excellence in competencies, skills, abilities and motivation of both teaching and non-teaching staff of educational organizations.

The Centre would like to assume the crucial role in developing critical and innovative thinking, Counseling, research, consultancy and extension work. The main focus of the centre is as under:

- 1. Professional Development of teachers by organizing General Orientation & Subject specific and knowledge up gradation Refresher Courses.
- 2. Special capacity building programmes for women and underprivileged staff.
- 3. Sensitisation workshop on nation building in line with constitutional ethos.
- 4. Awareness about Ecology, environment and climate change & the art of living among the youth.
- 5. Building leadership qualities in youth and training them through value based education and composite culture.
- 6. Information, Technology awareness and launching of short term courses on MOOC plate form to make our programmes available to those who are not able to attend our programmes physically.
- Development of E-Content and digitise the lectures of top notch resource persons which would be available to the students, scholars, teachers, staff and general public 24x7.
- 8. Development of interactive website on various issues of education and societal needs.
- 9. Methodology workshops for Research Scholars in the areas of Sciences, Social Sciences & Humanities to be organized, so that innovative ideas get birth and new approaches would be searched to nurture these ideas into research projects, patents and products.
- 10. Undertaking specific skill development programmes through which employability of the students and the research scholars will improve.

#### Cumulative Performance of 2013-2014:

Since its inception, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir has conducted 64 General Orientation and 125 Refresher Courses that were attended by a total of 4647 college and university teachers. Besides these courses 12 short-term courses on different topics have also been conducted that were attended by a total of 504 participants that included college principals, heads of departments and senior administrative officers of various educational institutions of the valley. Out of a total of 1746 participants that have attended 64 General Orientation Course conducted by the UGC-Human Resource Development Centre, 1161 were male and 585 were female whereas 1399 participants were from within and 347 from outside the valley of Kashmir. Similarly in case of 125 Refresher Courses conducted by the College so far, out of a total of 2901 participants, 2028 were male and 873 were female participants whereas 1881 were from within and 1020 from outside the valley of Kashmir. During the session 2013-2014, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir conducted three General Orientation, three Refresher and three short-term courses. Refresher Courses were conducted in the subjects of Applied Sciences, Arts, and Computer Applications, Other Course Special Winter School, Special Summer School and short term courses were conducted on Research Methodology in Disaster Management, Basic Computer & Acc. for Non Teaching Staff, Ph.D/M.Phill Research Scholars.

#### Cumulative Performance of 2014-2015:

Since its inception, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir has conducted 67 General Orientation and 134 Refresher Courses that were attended by a total of 4920 college and university teachers. Besides these courses 15 short-term courses on different topics have also been conducted that were attended by a total of 626 participants that included college principals, heads of departments and senior administrative officers of various educational institutions of the valley. Out of a total of 1811 participants that have attended 67 General Orientation Course conducted by the UGC-Human Resource Development Centre, 1209 were male and 602 were female whereas 1452 participants were from within and 359 from outside the valley of Kashmir. Similarly in case of 134 Refresher Courses conducted by the College so far, out of a total of 3109 participants, 2166 were male and 943 were female participants whereas 2044 were from within and 1065 from outside the valley of Kashmir. During the session 2014-2015, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir conducted three General Orientation, seven Refresher and three short-term courses. Refresher Courses were conducted in the subjects of Applied Sciences, Education, Physical Education & Psychology, Indian Languages, Human Rights, Disaster Management, Gender Studies and Commerce, Management & Economics, Other Course Special Winter School, Special Summer School and short term courses were conducted on Research Methodology in Sciences, Social Sciences, Commerce & Management and Languages.

#### **Cumulative Performance during 2015-2016:**

Since its inception, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir has conducted 70 General Orientation and 141 Refresher Courses that were attended by a total of 5235 college and university teachers. Besides these courses 21 short-

term courses on different topics have also been conducted that were attended by a total of 955 participants that included college principals, heads of departments and senior administrative officers of various educational institutions of the valley. Out of a total of 1894 participants that have attended 70 General Orientation Course conducted by the UGC-Human Resource Development Centre, 1267 were male and 627 were female whereas 1508 participants were from within and 386 from outside the valley of Kashmir. Similarly in case of 141 Refresher Courses conducted by the College so far, out of a total of 3341 participants, 2301 were male and 1040 were female participants whereas 2215 were from within and 1126 from outside the valley of Kashmir. During the session 2015-2016, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir conducted three General Orientation, five Refresher and four short-term courses. Refresher Courses were conducted in the subjects of Life Sciences, Human Rights, Teacher Educators, Disaster Management, and Gender Studies, Other Course Special Winter School, Special Summer School, One Day RTI, One Day Principal's Meet and short term courses were conducted on Research Methodology in Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities and IT.

### **Cumulative Performance during 2016-2017:**

Since its inception, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir has conducted 74 General Orientation and 144 Refresher Courses that were attended by a total of 5453 college and university teachers. Besides these courses 24 short-term courses on different topics have also been conducted that were attended by a total of 1081 participants that included college principals, heads of departments and senior administrative officers of various educational institutions of the valley. Out of a total of 2012 participants that have attended 74 General Orientation Course conducted by the UGC-Human Resource Development Centre, 1354 were male and 658 were female whereas 1607 participants were from within and 405 from outside the valley of Kashmir. Similarly in case of 144 Refresher Courses conducted by the College so far, out of a total of 3441 participants, 2365 were male and 1076 were female participants whereas 2301 were from within and 1140 from outside the valley of Kashmir. During the session 2016-2017, UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of the University of Kashmir conducted Four General Orientation, two Refresher and three short-term courses. Refresher Courses were conducted in the subjects of Child Development and Behavioural Science, Other Course Special Summer School, and short term courses were conducted on Research Methodology in Sciences, Social Sciences and IT.
