Meeting Agenda: Revision of the Undergraduate Syllabi in light of Semester Scheme

The meeting began with a welcome note by the present Head of the Department, **Prof. Ravinderjit Kaur**, who welcomed the members of the Board of Undergraduate Studies and apprised the members of the Board of the New Semester System adopted by the University of Kashmir for the Academic Session 2015. She called upon the Academic Councillor of the Department for Undergraduate Studies, Mr. Javid Ahmad, to throw some light on the scheme and the proposed changes. Mr. Javid Ahmad made brief introductory remarks about the new semester system and the rationale of restructuring the Undergraduate Course. The new structure and placement of the Courses at the undergraduate level is proposed as an "incremental step" towards the Ne

w Curriculum recommended by the University Grants Commission and endorsed by the University of Kashmir. It was suggested by the Academic Councillor that the undergraduate students of political science should be trained in mainstream discipline in the first two years of the programme. The members of the Board also spoke about the efficacy of proposed restructuring of the Undergraduate Curriculum and underlined the need to bring it in line with the new curriculum system that is being adopted by the various universities of India.



Semester Scheme for U.G Level in Political Science from 2015.

It is notified for the information all concerned that the syllabus for Semester System at Undergraduate level for the academic session 2015 shall be prepared as per the following Scheme:-

1. There shall be four units for each paper/course. Each unit shall have equal weightage in terms of content;;
2. Weightage of marks for semester and examination and internal assessment will be in the ratio of 80:20;
3. Distribution of internal assessment marks shall be decided by the controller of Examination in consultation with representative principals;
4. Question paper will comprise two sections viz; Section A & Section B. Section A will consist of four medium answer type questions will alternative for each. All the the questions will be compulsory. Section B shall consist of four long answer type questions and the candidate will be required to attempt only two questions.
5. Section A will carry 60% marks and section B 40% marks;
6. The question paper shall be of 2.30 hour's duration

The meeting began with a welcome note by the Head of the Department, Prof. Peerzada Irshad Ahmad Shah, who welcomed the members and apprised the members of the New CBCS adopted by the University of Kashmir for the Academic Session 2017 again.

Curriculum recommended by the University Grants Commission for the Skill Enhancement was deemed as a best guide to the aforementioned courses at the University of Kashmir. It was suggested by the Academic Councillor that apart from the goal of training undergraduate students of political science in mainstream discipline in the first two years of the programme, an opportunity ought to be given to the students of other disciplines to learn basic skill required for the life of citizenry.

Resolutions:

It was resolved that:

1. The proposed structure of the Skill Enhancement Courses shall operate from Semester III to Semester VI: One Course in each Semester.
2. The scheme shall be as follows: **Legislative Support; Public Opinion and Survey Research; Democratic Awareness with Legal Literacy; and Conflict and Peace Building** for semesters III, IV, V and VI, respectively.





Minutes of the meeting for UG 3rd semester syllabi held on 13th December, 2017 in the office chamber of the Head of the Department.


A meeting of all the Heads of Political Science was held on 13th December, 2017 in the office chamber of the undersigned with regard to finalizing the syllabi for 3rd semester Under Graduate level. The list of the member's alongwith their signatures present in the meeting is enclosed.

From the feedback received from the HoD's/ Representatives it was clear that all the collages except Degree Collage Budgam have taught **"Comparative Government and Politics"**(PS-3-CR-3) paper during the semester 3rd. Only Degree collage Budgam has taught **"Introduction to International Relations"**(PS-4-CR-4) paper.

Degree collage Tral has given it in writing that they have opted for **"Comparative Government and Politics"** paper instead of **"Introduction to International Relations"** (PS-4-CR-4) paper as indicated earlier.

It was, therefore, unanimously resolved that for all the collages of Kashmir Valley the question paper for UG 3rd semester should be set from **"Comparative Government and Politics"** paper. However, as an exceptional case, for Degree collage Budgam **"Introduction to International Relations"** paper may be treated as 3rd semester paper for current session and the question paper may be set accordingly.

The approved syllabi for semester 3rd **"Comparative Government and Politics"**(PS-3-CR-3) is herewith enclosed.
