w Curriculum recommended by the University Grants Commission and endorsed by the University of Kashmir. It was suggested by the Academic Councillor that the undergraduate students of political science should be trained in mainstream discipline in the first two years of the programme. The members of the Board also spoke about the efficacy of proposed restructuring of the Undergraduate Curriculum and underlined the need to bring it in line with the new curriculum system that is being adopted by the various universities of India.

Semester Scheme for U.G Level in Political Science from 2015.

It is notified for the information all concerned that the syllabus for Semester System at Undergraduate level for the academic session 2015 shall be prepared as per the following Scheme:-

- 1. There shall be four units for each paper/course. Each unit shall have equal weightage in terms of content:;
- 2. Weightage of marks for semester and examination and internal assessment will be in the ratio of 80:20;
- 3. Distribution of internal assessment marks shall be decided by the controller of Examination in consultation with representative principals;
- 4. Question paper will comprise two sections viz; Section A & Section B. Section A will consist of four medium answer type questions will alternative for each. All the the questions will be compulsory. Section B shall consist of four long answer type questions and the candidate will be required to attempt only two questions.
- 5. Section A will carry 60% marks and section B 40% marks;
- 6. The question paper shall be of 2.30 hour's duration

From the feedback received from the HoD's/ Representatives it was clear that all the collages except Degree Collage Budgam have taught "Comparative Government and Politics" (PS-3-CR-3) paper during the semester 3rd. Only Degree collage Budgam has taught "Introduction to International Relations" (PS-4-CR-4 paper.

Degree collage Tral has given it in writing that they have opted for "Comparative Government and Politics" paper instead of "Introduction to International Relations" (PS-4-CR-4) paper as indicated earlier.

It was, therefore, unanimously resolved that for all the collages of Kashmir Valley the question paper for UG 3rd semester should be set from "Comparative Government and Politics" paper. However, as an exceptional case, for Degree collage Budgam "Introduction to International Relations" paper may be treated as 3rd semester paper for current session and the question paper may be set accordingly.
